At night, I turned on the light and the living room was very bright. We got our lights back! It was dark and dim, and then when we got the lights back, we all felt a great sense of liveliness. It was dinner time. Claire said, "Wow! Now, I can see the colors of the food!" And Sean said, "It seems way brighter since we got our lights back after darkness." My family began to gather to in the living room again. We didn't know the value of the lights when we had them. But after three months of darkness, the value of the lights has increased.

The reason Jesus' resurrection is so precious is because his resurrection came after the darkness of death. The darkness that no one can defeat or avoid. The biggest point of despair for human beings. But Jesus Christ defeated death and was resurrected. He came back into our lives and became the light of our lives. 



April Food for Hope


